To make software more intuitive and user-friendly, ReSound conducted extensive usability studies. We studied how people actually use fitting software and incorporated this information into the new design. We wanted to design to the 80/20 rule, which in the world of software generally means that 80% of users will only use 20% of the features. Therefore, we sought to identify the most common 20% of features and make those most accessible to the user, while making the other 80% less prominent but still available for advanced users.

In line with that philosophy, the party and traffic programs were removed from Smart Fit due to low usage and similar properties to other programs that were more commonly used. If you wish to replicate the party or traffic programs, you can do so using the information below.

To replicate a Traffic program in Smart Fit, start with an Outdoor program:

- Increase NoiseTracker II to "Considerable"
- Turn WindGuard off
- Adjust the G50 gain as shown in the chart below
